Army Bobby “Bob” Bogard accomplished many things in his life, but he was most proud of his career as an Army Aviator with the Army Corps of Engineers. In his 21 years as a fixed wing and helicopter Pilot, he had over 6,000 hours of flight time to his credit. Among his military awards are a Legion of Merit, *Distinguished Flying Cross*, Meritorious Service Medal, two Bronze Stars, 23 Air Medals and 3 Army Commendation Medals. He also received the highest award given to civilians, from the country of Guatemala where he lived and worked for 4 years.
