



Distinguished Flying Cross Award Citation

Technical Sergeant Robert B. Davis distinguished himself by extraordinary achievement while participating in aerial flight as an AC-130A Flight Engineer on 7 and 8 March 1968. On those dates, Sergeant Davis was flying on an armed reconnaissance combat mission against hostile forces. With great determination and superior airmanship, he performed his engineering duties on an extremely hazardous mission through areas of intense antiaircraft fire. Through the skill and truly professional efforts of Sergeant Davis, a large volume of hostile forces' supplies and vehicles were destroyed. The professional competence, aerial skill and devotion to duty displayed by Sergeant Davis reflect great credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
