

AUDICK, ALBERT E. July 18, 1922 June 25, 2004

Retired U.S. Air Force Colonel Albert E. Audick, 81, former Commander of Armed Forces Radio and Television Services (AFRTS) in Hollywood, died June 25th while vacationing in Kauai, Hawaii. Al's three decade military career began in WW II. His service included 35 missions in Vietnam. He served as Director of Information for NORAD in Colorado and for the Fifth Air Force in Japan. After his Air Force career, Al worked for the Sony Corporation in Washington D.C. In 1990, he retired to Los Angeles where he had been an active member of the Pacific Pioneers of broadcasting and several military veteran groups. Born in Boston, Massachusetts, he and his wife Stella Joanne Audick raised ten children, Al, John, Ron, Susan, Dan, Paula, Carole, David, Mike, and Chris. With their families he has been an adored grandfather to Melissa, Alan, Lauren, Patrick, Xavier, Gabriel, Kyle, Kaitlyn, Kevin, Meaghan, Kate, Julie, Savanna, Zachary, Dillon, Beckett, Max, Ryan and Jacob and a cherished great grandfather to Tim and Tyler. His wife Stella and two sons, Albert Jr. and Ronald, preceded him in death.
