Lt. Col. Norbert L. Mueller (Nubs) USAF Retired Lt. Col. Norbert L. (Nubs) Mueller, USAF Retired, of Round Rock, passed away Friday, May 8, 2009. He was born on March 23, 1932, in Readlyn, Iowa to Lorenz and Hertha Mueller. His family moved to Portage, Wisconsin in 1944, where he graduated from High School. He attended Valparaiso University in Indiana for two years prior to enlisting in the Air Force in 1952. He graduated from the Navigator Aviation Cadet program in 1954 and was commissioned a Second Lieutenant. He served at numerous locations in Texas, France,

Nevada, Thailand, Germany and Illinois and retired on April 1, 1972, at Scott AFB, Illinois in the rank of Lt. Col. His decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal, Air Medal, Air Force Commendation Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Viet Nam Service Medal, Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Republic of Viet Nam Campaign Medal and Armed Forces Reserve Medal. He moved to Austin upon his retirement from the Air Force and was employed by the Texas Highway Department as an Equipment Purchaser. He later transferred to the Automation Division where he supervised the User Support Section of the Division. He retired from the Department of Highways and Public Transportation on October 1, 1993. He had one sister, Elaine, who preceded him in death in 1989 as did his parents in 1985 and 1991. He is survived by the love of his life, his most wonderful wife, Pat, of 18 years and numerous children: Larry Mueller and wife Wendy and Granddaughter Gemma, Karen Henry and husband Tim, Sandra Damon and husband Jake and granddaughter Jasper Sage; Terri Park and husband Bruce Van Waes, grandson Clint and wife Kenna, and grandson Kyle; Randy Bishop and wife Lisa, granddaughters Andrea and Emily and great grandson Princeton; Claudio Della Corte and wife Johna, granddaughter Angela and great granddaughter Emma; and Clay and Brenda Collier.
