

## **BARBARA EBERLE**

HAGUE — Barbara Eberle, 85, formerly of Hague and Bismarck, died May 1, 2000, in Fredricksburg, Va. Services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Friday at St. Mary's Catholic Church, Hague, with the Rev. Leonard Eckroth officiating. Burial will be in the church cemetery. Visitation will be from 3-9 p.m. today at Myers Funeral Home, Unton, where a prayer service will begin at 7 tonight. Visitation will continue at the church one hour before services.
