Felix Eberle, 84, Rugby, died Wednesday, Jan. 9, 2002, in Heart of America Long-term Care Center, Rugby., Felix Eberle was born June 9, 1917, the son of Pius and Eva (Jaeger) Eberle in Slaton, Texas. In 1919, he moved with his family to Karlsruhe, N. D., where he attended school. In 1932, he moved with his family to the Baker, N. D., area, where they farmed. He married Irene Sosalla on Sept. 23, 1939, in Leeds, N. D. They lived and farmed near Baker. They moved to Rugby in 1980. He retired from farming in 1989. Irene Eberle died Nov. 11, 1992.
