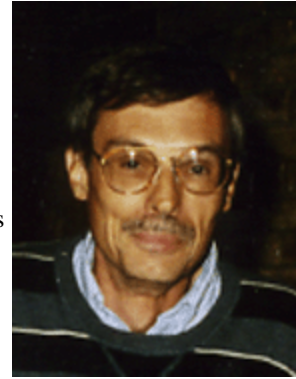


Patrick Wald • 1950 - 2005
