

**MRS. ANDREW WELK
OF HARVEY DIES**

Mrs. Andrew (Mary Anne) Welk, 85, died Friday at Harvey. Funeral Mass was Monday in St. Cecelia Church, Rev. O. P. O'Neil celebrant.

Mary Anne Keller was born in Russia Sept. 28, 1880 and came to the United States in 1899 to settle at Aberdeen. She was married there Aug. 17, 1901. They came to Karlsruhe in 1915 and moved to Harvey in 1935. Mr. Welk died nearly 20 years ago.

She leaves three sons and one daughter, Andrew, Harvey; August, Dearborn, Mich.; Louis, Tucson, Ariz.; and Mrs. William Putz, Minot.
