(National has no Citation) Research Information: Lieutenant Colonel Witterman's military career spanned more than 27 years and included over eight years of enlisted service. A highly decorated combat Pilot, he flew almost 600 sorties in Vietnam and was forced down twice over enemy territory. He earned the Distinguished Flying Cross for heroism and extraordinary achievement while participating in "Operation Cricket" (a mission later named "Operation Raven"). ("Operation Cricket", May 13-July 16, 1967, 1st and 2nd Battalions, 26th Marines search and destroy operation in the Quang Tri Province.) Col. Witterman is buried in Arlington National Cemetery.
