

THE CLARK FAMILY

ANTHONY CLARK was born in Ireland, June 21, 1739; died July 15, 1827. He emigrated to America before 1775, and died in Rutherford County, Tennessee, where he was a farmer. On November 3, 1774, he married his first wife, Mary Oates, (who was born in Ireland, November 4, 1749, and died June 14, 1797.) He married a second time, but the name of his second wife is not of record. By the first marriage, he had nine children, and by the second marriage he had three children. (One of Anthony Clark's brothers was killed in the battle of Bunker Hill.)

RUFUS ANTHONY CLARK.

R. A. Clark was born near Pelham, Coffee County, Tennessee, November 20, 1845. He came to Winchester in the fall of 1872, and began teaching in the Carrick Academy, of which school he was Principal until 1877, having associated with him at that time, as co-workers, his brother, Isaac Clark, and Professor J. M. Bledsoe.

During the summer of 1899 the directors of the normal elected Mr. Clark President, and for twenty years this splendid school did its greatest work under his guiding hand, and from his influence many boys and girls were given an impulse to high and holy lives that it was his greatest desire and ambition to give. He never grew weary of appealing to the students to do their class work faithfully and well; but, above all that, he urged them to think pure thoughts, to say pure words, and to do kindly and noble deeds; to prove themselves men and women who would make the world better by their having lived in it.

As the fatal end drew near, while he hoped to live, he realized the chances were against him, and, still full of the same determination to do all he could, he was willing to accept the Lord's will, and calmly and quietly waited the end with all his children, whom he loved devotedly, at his side.
