Subject: Final Meeting of the Evreux Alumni Group 3 Oct 2009

Introduction: 39 members and 24 wives and guests enjoyed our last reunion from 30 Sept to 4 Oct in San Antonio. It was well-managed by the Reunion Brat; however, it was a not the same as the many previous reunions because of the absence of Norbert Mueller, our long serving Chairman of the Executive Committee, who died almost 4 months before the meeting. Also, at the last moment his wife Pat, an indispensable leader with Nubs, had to cancel her planned attendance because of a viral infection. Another disappointment was the absence of Charlie Spika, because of health problems.

Business Meeting: On Saturday morning the Membership /Business meeting began at 0900 as scheduled. Chuck Wilson and Jim McGinley, as the only attending members of the Executive committee, assumed responsibility for opening the meeting. Results were as follows:

a. A successor to Nubs Mueller was the first issue to be addressed.

Despite several suggestions by Chuck Wilson and a few from the floor, there were no volunteers to assume Nub's duties. For this reason and the dwindling attendance at the last few reunions a motion to disband the Group was made, seconded and unanimously approved.

b. Disposal of approximately \$2100 remaining in an account managed by the Reunion Brat was then addressed..Suggestions and decisions were:

(1) Underwrite cost of an inanimate memorial such as a plaque or inscription recognizing/honoring some aspect of the Group. This suggestion was disapproved by a large majority.

(2) Forward the assets to the 317th Reunion Group. The response to this suggestion was negative.

(3) Donate the funds to an organization such as "Wounded Warriors". A lively discussion of this suggestion ensued . A motion was made and seconded to make this donation and it was approved by a large majority. Chuck Wilson asked for a volunteer to get details of the Wounded Warrior organization and report results at the dinner meeting. One member agreed to do this.

c. The Meeting adjourned at approximately 10:00.

Dinner Meeting.

a. Chuck Wilson opened the meeting at 2000 after the cocktail hour, greeting and welcoming members and guests, especially Lee Worley and her daughter and son.



b. Greg Devejian then introduced a friend/classmate retired Army Colonel who is actively involved with the Warrior Support Center at Fort Sam Houston. This excellent presentation was consistent with the vote to donate funds to the Wounded Warrior Project. The report on status of the Wounded Warrior Project was then given by the business-meeting volunteer.-The essence was favorable in all respects.

c.. With help of Stacy Tucker, Reunion Brat Coordinator, a Missing Man Table and Honors Ceremony was then conducted. After the Pledge of Allegiance and Invocation Chuck gave an explanation of the Missing Man table set with special reference to Nubs Mueller.

d. After dinner Chuck introduced the Guest Speaker, Chief Master Sergeant William D.L.Dambacher. He gave an excellent motivational address and after dinner his wife was introduced and presented with flowers, congratulating them on their 24th Wedding Anniversary.

Conclusion: The Dinner Meeting was adjourned about 23:00, ending the Evreux Alumni Group and its predecessor, the 465th TC Gp Reunion Organization, begun about twenty years ago by Colonel Barlow and the Toul AB "Pioneers"
