He was also known as Anton Merk on 3 Jun 1912.<sup>6</sup> He immigrated on 3 Jun 1912 to Laredo, Texas.<sup>7-9</sup> Anthony lived temporarily while working for the railroad in Hatton, Traill County, North Dakota, USA on 12 Sep 1918.<sup>3</sup> He registered for the draft (WWI) on 12 Sep 1918 in Hillsboro, Traill County, North Dakota, USA.<sup>3</sup> He appeared in the census on 9 Jan 1920 in Northwood, Grand Forks County, North Dakota, USA.<sup>10</sup> On 9 Jan 1920 Anthony was a clerk for the Great Northern Railroad in Northwood, Grand Forks County, North Dakota, USA.<sup>10</sup> Between 1922 and 1964 he was a Railroad Depot Agent and Telegrapher for the Great Northern Railroad in the Red River Valley of North Dakota and Minnesota, USA.<sup>11-12</sup> He appeared in the census on 1 Apr 1930 in Humboldt, Kittson County, Minnesota, USA.<sup>13</sup> Anthony retired 1964 from the Great Northern RR in Argyle, Marshall County, Minnesota, USA.<sup>14</sup> He died appendicitis with perforations, embolus left superficial femoral artery, on 22 Dec 1964 at the age of 66 at James Walker Hospital in Wilmington, New Hanover Co., North Carolina, USA.<sup>14-15</sup> He was buried after Dec 1964 at Greenwood Cemetery in Hallock, Kittson County, Minnesota, USA.<sup>14</sup> Anthony was naturalized in Marshall County, Minnesota, USA.<sup>16</sup> He was Roman Catholic and a Fourth degree Knight of Columbus.<sup>5</sup>
